TIME Bus leaves **YOUTH CLUB & LOCATION**

- 8:30** Volunteers meet @ Squaw base inside the Snowboard Rental Shop building (Olympic House) by the fireplace/ Wildflour Baking Co. - for lift tickets & instructions. (Diagonally behind Cable Car building.)
- 9:00** **RENTALS:** Bus arrives at @ Squaw Valley; meet SkiDUCK volunteers inside the Snowboard Rental Shop building (diagonally behind of the Cable Car building) - bench seating by Wildflour bakery) for lift tickets/instructions. (Rental forms should be completed before arriving or at the rental shop, some info is on youth liability waivers. *Mention any skiers (vs snowboarders) to the SkiDUCK lead volunteer, as equipment is in a different building. (Be sure to ask if anyone needs to use restrooms before lessons, and mention High Camp Wildflour lunch area to meet after lessons.)* **Also, gloves, goggles, and clothing check and distribution.**
- 10:00** **LESSONS:** Level 1 & 2 (Beginner) lessons meet in front of the snowboard rental shop by the Bullwheel. Squaw Valley instructors will take classes up to High Camp beginner area via the Cable Car. Level 3-7 (Intermediate/Advanced) lessons meet at base of the Funitel (instructors determine where classes begins/ends). – Inform Level 3-7 students to meet at High Camp building's Wildflour lunch area immediately after lessons.
- 12:30** **LUNCH:** Pick up Level 1-2 students from High Camp ski school area, up to 1 hour **SACK LUNCH** at High Camp (Terrace cafeteria if space available or small area by Wallflour Deli).
- 1:30** **FREE RIDE:** 2 hours free-riding with kids. (Lifts OK if all kids in group were taught to use lifts during their lesson.) **Be sure to tell all kids to be back to the top of Bailey's Beach/ski school starting area BY 3:30.**
- 3:30** Beginners head down to base of mountain via Cable Car, to return rental equipment & meet with group. More advanced riders can ride down River Run but **ONLY** with a chaperone and group. *(The kids just need to mention SkiDUCK when they return equipment, no yellow return slips are needed.)*
- 4:00** Load bus and depart Squaw Valley USA.

Safety first, then have fun... the learning & skills will come.

Adult Volunteer Liability Waivers MUST be completed/signed in order to participate.

Any youth without a parent-signed Liability Waiver MUST sit out the entire day.
