- 3:00** Bus leaves **LOCATION**
- 3:30** Volunteers meet at the Base Lodge at the Tuxedo Ridge Ski Area (1st building on the left as you walk up the hill). Turn in liability waiver & receive group overview.
- 4:00** Kids arrive at the Rental Shop for short overview of event (rental shop, lessons, lunch, free-ski). Hand out lift tickets & start Rentals process. **Also, check if any kids need gloves, goggles, and clothing – or need to use the restroom** in rental building.
- 4:45** Entire group of students moves to the lesson area; lessons start at **5:00 sharp**. (Approx 1.5 hours for adult free skiing)
- 6:15** Pick up students from ski school, up 1/2 hour SNACK (Main lodge inside/outside TBD). Kids should NOT turn in their rental equipment if they want to free-ride for the rest of the evening!
- 6:45** ~2 hours free skiing with kids. (Lifts OK if all kids in group were taught to use lifts during their lesson, or if chaperone instructs them how to use the lift.) **Be sure to tell all kids in your group to return to rental shop area by 8:45 to return equipment, even if split up from the group.**
- 8:45** Kids return rental equipment (no paperwork needed).
- 9:00** Load bus & depart.
- 10:00** Bus arrives at **LOCATION**

Any youth without a parent-signed Liability Waiver MUST sit out the entire day.***
